City Of Hamilton By-Law:

"By-law No. 11-080 Prohibiting Smoking within City Parks and Recreation Properties will come into effect on May 31, 2012. This By-law will prohibit smoking in the following areas:

parks
playgrounds
recreation centre property
arena and stadium property
sports or playing fields
skateboard parks
beaches
outdoor pools
leash-free dog parks

The goals of this By-law include:

protecting the health and safety of the community, especially children
supporting local groups who use City facilities to promote healthy lifestyles
reducing cigarette butt litter, environmental degradation and improving city image

•reducing risks of fire and health hazards for children

- •positive role-modeling for children and youth to decrease the likelihood of them starting smoking
 - providing smoke-free environments to encourage people who smoke to quit."
